PRENTISS TRANSFER STATION Disposal Fees and Procedures for Accepting Dry Rubble and White Goods

All vehicles must weigh in and out of the site.

DISPOSAL FEES FOR DRY RUBBLE WASTE

A per tonne levy for materials going into the dry rubble site is as follows:

- If net weight of materials is between 500 kg to 1,000 kg, a minimum charge of \$20 fee will apply. Vehicles with over 1,000 kg will be charged \$20/tonne. There will be no charge for 499 kg or less.
- Minimum charge of \$100.00 per load for **unsorted** loads.
- Levy to be set at **\$20.00 per tonne**.

ACCEPTABLE WASTES – Dry Rubble Site

The Prentiss Class III Landfill and Waste Transfer Site is permitted to take Class III waste (solid, inert, non-hazardous waste) at the landfill. On this basis, the landfill is permitted to accept inert wastes that are not reasonably expected to undergo physical, chemical or biological changes that would result in adverse effects on the environment (may include, but is not limited to, demolition debris, concrete, asphalt, glass, ceramic materials, scrap metal and dry timber, or woods that have not been chemically treated).

DISPOSAL FEES FOR WHITE GOODS

Disposal fees will be implemented at the Prentiss Transfer Site beginning July 1st, 2003. All white goods (fridges, stoves, washers, dryers, dishwashers, hot water tanks, etc.) will be subject to a minimum disposal charge. **All white goods will be directed to the Prentiss Transfer Site from other transfer sites within Lacombe County.**

- Minimum charge for white goods \$5.00 per unit.
 - Fridges with refrigerants (freon, etc.) drained and complete **with a certificate** from an authorized technician will be subject to the minimum charge of *\$5.00 per unit*.
 - Fridges with refrigerants or **do not have a certificate** from an authorized technician (Freon, etc.) will be subject to a *\$25.00 per unit disposal charge*.
