**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BLACKFALDS TO AMEND TOWN OF BLACKFALDS BYLAW 1080/09  
TO REGULATE THE HANDLING, COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE, ASHES AND OTHER  
WASTE IN THE TOWN OF BLACKFALDS SCHEDULE A AND SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS  
THERETO.**

A Bylaw of the Town of Blackfalds, in the Province of Alberta, pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act being chapter M-26.1 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 and amendments thereto, to provide for amendments to Bylaw 1080/09 establishing to regulate the handling, collection and disposal of garbage, ashes and other waste in the Town of Blackfalds.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council deems it necessary and expedient to amend Bylaw 1080/09 Schedule A and subsequent amendments thereto.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Town of Blackfalds, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

THAT Bylaw No. 1080/09 Schedule A is hereby amended as follows:

**1. ESTABLISHMENT**

**SCHEDULE "A"**

- 1.0 Residential minimum rate: Effective January 1, 2010 of \$22.82 per month  
The above monthly Minimum rate will apply to all residential properties.  
Should a resident request to discontinue the garbage service the resident will continue to be responsible to pay the monthly minimum rate
- 2.0 Commercial minimum rate: Effective January 1, 2010 will be charged directly by Waste Management Corporation of Canada according to the Town Contract.  
Rates for properties when supplied with containers by a contractor shall be the rate charged by the contractor.  
The above monthly rate will apply to all non-residential properties.
- 3.0 Church minimum rate: Effective January 1, 2010 will be \$22.82 per month.  
The above monthly rate will apply to all church properties.
- 4.0 Cardboard Recycling bins shall be charged as per the rate prescribed by the Contractor.
- 5.0 Large Commercial Solid Waste bins shall be charged as per the rate prescribed by the Contractor.
- 6.0 Purchase of Blue Box Recycling Bins - \$11.00 plus GST per box.

This Bylaw shall come into effect upon the date on which it is finally read and passed.
