A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BLACKFALDS IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO CLOSE A PORTION OF A ROAD CONTAINED WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF BLACKFALDS

A Bylaw of the Town of Blackfalds, in the Province of Alberta, pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act being chapter M-26.1 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 and amendments thereto.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council may pass a Bylaw for the purpose of closing any road provided that the bylaw is advertised and any person who claims to be affected prejudicially by the bylaw, or their agent, has been given an opportunity of being heard by the Municipal Council in relation to the proposed Bylaw; and

WHEREAS the Municipal Council has considered the proposed closing and has agreed that it is in the public interest to pass this Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BLACKFALDS, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

That the following road be closed

Firstly:
Plan 022 7688
All that portion of Westridge Drive contained within the limits of Area A, Plan 102
Containing 0.02 Hectares (0.50 Acres) more or less

EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS

Secondly:
Plan 022 7688
All that portion of Westridge Drive contained within the limits of Area B, Plan 102
Containing 0.561 hectares (1.39 acres) more or less

EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS
