WHAT IS THE LEISURE ACCESS PROGRAM?

The Town of Blackfalds will subsidize, when possible, fees for individuals and families who are unable to pay for municipally operated programs, memberships and admissions that would contribute to their personal growth and community involvement. Through this program, the quality of life and well-being of Blackfalds residents will be greatly improved; creating a strong and healthy community.

HOW DO I KNOW IF I QUALIFY?

To be eligible for LAP funding, your family household's annual income - which includes all persons living in the same dwelling and related by blood, marriage, common-law relationship or adoption - needs to be below the Statistics Canada Low Income Cut-offs (LICOs).

If you qualify, you will receive \$100 gift card (per family member) for use with municipally operated programs, memberships and admissions.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Why do you need to know the number of family members in my household?

In order to be approved for the LAP Fund, your annual *Family household* income needs to be below the Statistics Canada Low Income Cut-offs (LICOs). Statistics Canada uses "the economic family that is, all persons living in the same dwelling and related by blood, marriage, common-law relationships or adoption" model. In order to consider you for the LAP fund, we must use the same model.

How long does it take to process the LAP application?

Please allow up to 4 weeks to process. You will be notified should you not qualify. If you have not received anything after one (1) month of submitting your application please contact FCSS at 403.600.9066.

Can I use my LAP funding for Minor Hockey fees?

LAP funding is applicable for Town of Blackfalds programming or facility admissions only. There are other subsidies that you can access for other programs. Please contact FCSS for further information.

What if I'm not approved for LAP?

If you have been declined and your financial situation has changed, you are welcome to re-apply. There is no waiting period between applications required.

How do I receive my LAP funding?

Once you have qualified for LAP, you will receive \$100 gift card (per family member) for use with municipally operated programs, memberships and admissions.
