Business Arising from Minutes

Amended 2017 Operating & Capital Budget

- Council moved to accept the recommendation of Administration in amending the 2017 Operating budget of \$25,325,471 and the Capital budget of \$12,078,000 for a total budget of \$37,403,471, as well as amortization of \$4,700,000.

Bylaw 1211.17 – South Street Local Improvement

- Council gave Second and Third and Final Reading to Bylaw 1211/17 authorizing Council to impose a local improvement tax in respect of all lands that directly benefit from the South Street Extension.

Business

Bylaw 1213/17 - 2017 Property Tax Bylaw

- Council gave First, Second and Third and Final Readings of the 2017 Property Tax Bylaw 1213/17 as presented.

Municipal Property Assessment Contract

- Council moved to approve an extension of the Municipal Property Assessor contract with Bow Valley Property Valuers for an additional two years with a contract expiry date of September 1, 2019.

Tutty Pond MR Development Concept

- Council moved to support the recommendation of the Recreation, Culture and Parks Board to accept the Tutty Pond Landscape Concept Plan and directed Administration to implement the project in the current construction year for the price of \$90,000.

Cottonwood Playground Design Approval

- Council moved to support the recommendation of the Recreation, Culture and Parks Board to accept the design from BDI Play Design - Option 3 for the Cottonwood/School Playground for the amount of \$225,000.
