Delegation

2017 Mayor for the Day

- Grade 6 student Chantal Schunk was introduced as the 2017 Mayor for the Day at Council, and will be joining the Mayor at the 'Celebrating Canada 150' Parade on Saturday for Blackfalds Days. Two high quality submissions were received and the runner-up was Jamie-Marie Watamaniuk.

Bike Skills Park Presentation

- Jay Hoots of Hoots Inc. presented the concept for the new bike skills park in Blackfalds including layout and features.

Business

Bike Skills Park – Design Approval

- Town Council moved to support the recommendation of the Recreation, Culture and Parks Board to accept the Bikes Skills Park Final Design with Hoots Inc. for a maximum of \$400,000.

Property Tax Recovery Public Auction

- Council moved to approve the sale date for August 10, 2017 commencing at 10:00am in the Council Chambers, at 5018 Waghorn Street, Blackfalds, Alberta
- Council additionally moved to approve that the conditions of the sale be set as 25% deposit plus complete payment within 10 days from the date of sale and that the Reserve bid for the property be set at the 2017 Assessment value \$300,000.

Bylaw 1215.17 South Street Local Improvement Debenture Bylaw

- Council moved to give First, Second and Third Readings to Bylaw 1215.17 to approve the borrowing in the amount of \$789,930 for the Extension Water, Sanitary, Fire Suppression, Landscaping and Paving from Vista Trail to the west to the end of the street local improvement project.

Fire Rescue/Pumper #2

- Council moved to approve support retaining Rescue/Pumper Engine 2 as part of the Town of Blackfalds Fire Service operational apparatus.
