#### **BUSINESS**

##### **6.1 Intermunicipal Collaboration & Intermunicipal Development Plan (IDP) Committee**

Council appointed a third Council member to the IDP Committee, Councillor Hoover, with Councillor Stendie as the alternate.

Council also moved to appoint Councillors Hoover and Stendie to participate on the Intermunicipal Collaboration Committee with Mayor Poole and CAO Thompson.

##### **6.2 Municipal Sustainability Plan (MSP) Review**

CAO Thompson identified the critical step and indicators as part of the framework for action. The current year marks the 2nd year of the 3 year planning phase. Council chose to undertake the review mid-September of 2018, specifically Friday Sept. 15 and Saturday Sept. 16.

Council moved to defer this item so that Administration can find out the costs of having Intelligent Futures, the company that originally created the MSP, facilitate the review process.

##### **6.3 Valley Ridge Park Playground**

Council moved to approve the Recreation, Culture and Parks Board's recommendation to award the Valley Ridge Neighbourhood District playground to Canadian Recreation Solutions "Construction Theme" proposal for a total project budget of \$121,970.00.
