## Highlights of the Regular Meeting of Council – February 11, 2020

### Business Arising:

- **Bylaw 1241/20:** Council gave Second and Third and Final Readings to Bylaw 1241/20, being the Authorized Overdraft Bylaw. This Bylaw authorizes the Town to make use of overdraft protection if needed.
- **Bylaw 1242/20:** Council gave Second and Third and Final Readings to Bylaw 1242/20, being the Access to Information Bylaw, which updates access and privacy guidelines of the Town of Blackfalds.

### Business:

- **Policy 139.20:** Council approved Policy 139.20, being the Asset Management Policy for the purpose to facilitate the logical, methodical and informed decision making for the life-cycle planning of assets to achieve greater asset sustainability, and effective allocation of resources.
- **Branding Project Update – Logo Testing Survey Results:** Results of the Logo Testing Survey were presented by members of the Brand Development Committee and Council accepted the report as information.
- **Joint Council Meeting – City of Lacombe:** Both City of Lacombe and Blackfalds Town Council agreed to a joint meeting, scheduled for 5:00pm on May 4, 2020 in Blackfalds at the new Operations Centre.

### Action Correspondence:

- **Alberta Order of Excellence – Call for Nominations February 15, 2020:** Council accepted this for information.
- **RDRWA e-News January 20:** Council accepted for information and discussed Council attendance at the Spring Forum being held in Blackfalds on March 25, 2020, with Councillor Olfert attending on behalf of the municipality.
- **City of Red Deer Mayor Tara Veer email request:** Council moved to agree to be a signatory on the letter provided by Mayor Veer, asking the Province for an additional Crown Prosecutor in Red Deer. On December 19, 2019, on behalf of Blackfalds, Mayor Poole provided a separate letter of support to Premier Kenney, as request also by Red Deer.
