### **Business Arising from the Minutes**

#### **Bylaw 1256.21 to Repeal Temporary Face Coverings Bylaw 1253.20**

Emergency Management and Protective Services Manager presented the Bylaw 1256.21 to repeal Bylaw 1253.20 Face Coverings Bylaw which was approved by Council in November. This Bylaw to rescind was brought forward in consideration of the provincial mandate that requires face coverings in all public spaces in Alberta. Council approved the first, second, third and final reading for this Bylaw 1256.21.

#### **Request for Decision, New Motor Grader Award**

The Director of Infrastructure and Property Services presented two bid packages that were provided for purchasing a new motor grader. Finning was awarded the tender for a new 2021 Caterpillar 140-13 Motor Grader in the amount of \$278,343.00.

The Chief Administrative Officer brought forward the resignation of Member Tanya Wilson from the Municipal Library Board. Council approved this resignation, with regrets.
