Business

Request for Decision, Municipal Election Advanced Vote

Council reviewed and approved the proposed dates for the 2021 Municipal Election Advanced Vote and election signage locations. Advanced Vote Days were selected as follows, with the possible addition of another night of extended hours:

October 4 – 8, 12 – 15 from 9:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.

October 6 & 14 open late from 9:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.

October 16 from 10:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.

Request for Decision, Election Bylaw Amendment

The Election Bylaw was brought forward for amendment as Administration have changed the tabulators from entirely electronic, to paper ballot due to the addition of the referendum questions, which cannot fit on the previously used tabulators' screen. Council gave three readings and approved this amendment.

Request for Decision, Drive-in Movie/Fireworks Event Permit

A showing of War with Grandpa, preceded by the 9-minute Volunteer Recognition Video, will take place on June 18, 2021 at dusk (approximately 10 p.m.). On June 19, 2021 at a similar time a fireworks show will be hosted by the municipality at the location immediately to the east of the RCMP Detachment/Fire Hall.
